Hi League of Women Voters of Anchorage: As previously noted, 2024 is an election year - both on the local, state and federal level. Stay tuned for updates on elections at all levels. An informed electorate is necessary! The <u>Ballot Review</u> pamphlet will again be prepared by the Anchorage league for the Municipal election and will be mailed to all households in March. We all need to get out and vote. The election provides us all with an opportunity to express our opinions and stand up for what matters most to us.

<u>Point of Information</u>: In the United States, individual states decide how and when to register voters, which has often led to confusion. Just 13 states allow voter registration on Election Day. Alaska is NOT one of them!

MUNICIPAL ELECTION UPDATE

Anchorage's city election is coming up. Ballots go out March 12 and Election Day is April 2. <u>Become involved in putting together a questionnaire for the</u> <u>mayoral candidates</u>.

Alaska Public Media is in the process of putting together questionnaires for the mayoral candidates, in collaboration with the Anchorage Daily News. They want to provide a resource for voters, to help people understand where the candidates stand on the biggest issues facing our city.
